A <u>multisyllable word</u> is a word that has more than one syllable. <u>Decoding multisyllable words</u> means dividing, them into syllables.

Syllable Patterns	Examples
VC/CV When two consonants are in the middle, divide between them.	rab/bit pret/ty VC/CV
V/C-LE Divide before the consonant when it is followed by –le.	puz/zle V/C-le
